Boarding Policies

Our goal at the Orchard Mesa Veterinary Hospital is to make your pet's boarding experience pleasant and safe. We want you to be confident while you are away, knowing your pet is secure, comfortable, and receiving the best possible care.

Vaccinations:

For the protection of your pet, we require that your pet be current on the following vaccinations:

Cats:

Rabies

Feline Distemper Combination

Feline Leukemia

Dogs:

Rabies, one or three years

Distemper Combination

Bordetella—every 6 months

Influenza



Please provide written proof of vaccination history at least 48 hours prior to boarding.

Collars or harnesses are required so we can keep name tags on your pet. For your pet's safety, no choke, pinch or electric collars are allowed in the kennel.

Boarding Reservations:

We suggest that you **make reservations** for boarding as far in advance as possible, particularly over holidays.

You may confirm your boarding reservations by credit card just as you would in a human hotel. If you do not wish to use a credit card for confirmation, we require a deposit equaling two days boarding charges to hold your reservations. This deposit should be provided within 3 days after making the reservation.

If you are boarding for the first time, or boarding your pet for an extended period, you will be asked to provide payment in advance. This includes any costs for services provided such as vaccinations. If you need to extend your boarding beyond your scheduled check-out time, please let us know as soon as possible. There may be late fees associated with the additional days.

For your pet's safety, we request that any prescription medication your pet requires while staying at our facility be in its **original** container with the dosing instructions.

Cancellations:

We request that you provide 24-hour notice if you must cancel a reservation. For holiday boarding, please let us know at least 4 days in advance of your boarding appointment if you need to cancel. This allows us to schedule other clients who may be on a waiting list. We may

We have Pet Cots available upon request for your pet's comfort. Please feel free to bring items from home to make your pet's stay less stressful, such as toys, a towel or small blanket. Be sure to place your name on any items with permanent marker. Be aware that we may not be able to launder pet beds, should they become soiled during boarding.
