## The Nevada Chapter celebrates the 20th Anniversary of OST's Designation as a "National Historic Trail"

Nicole Marie Dominguez, OSTA Nevada Chapter President, gave a welcoming talk about the trail that operated between Santa Fe, New Mexico, and Los Angeles, California—a trail of 1,250 miles. She highlighted facts about the Trail beginning in Santa Fe that passed through southwestern Colorado, central and southwest Utah, northern Arizona, southern Nevada and on to the Plaza at Los Angeles.
